**Financial Aid**

You may fill out the anticipated financial aid section when meeting with the Financial Aid Administrator or using your Financial Aid Award Letter. Your financial aid is determined based on the information on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Students can apply at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) using our school code, 006331.

Most students who apply for financial aid will be eligible for the Federal Stafford Loan, a low-interest educational loan. If you will be accepting the loan(s) that is offered to you, you will need to complete the Master Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling online at [www.studentloans.gov](http://www.studentloans.gov).

**Options to Pay Balance**

Financial aid typically does not cover the full cost of your tuition and fees. We offer many options to pay your balance, including cash/check, credit card, an interest-free monthly payment plan and private educational loans (go to [www.finaid.org](http://www.finaid.org), then search "Private Loans").

The fall semester bill is mailed mid-June and is due July 15<sup>th</sup>. The winter intersession bill is due at the time of registration. The spring semester bill is mailed mid-November and is due December 15<sup>th</sup>. The summer session bill is mailed at the time of registration and is due May 1<sup>st</sup>. To secure your place in the course, payment and/or a loan must be secured by the bill due date.
